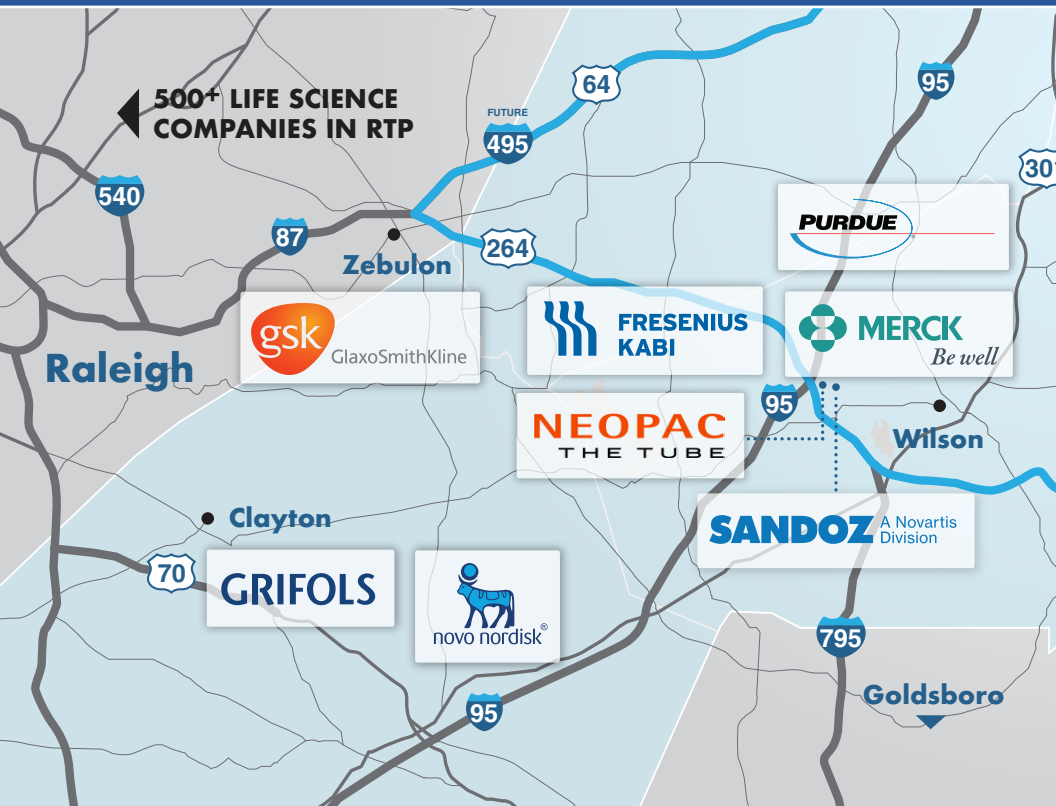


Strategic Location

The 576-acre site is located at the intersection of Old Battleboro Road and 7 Bridges Road in Battleboro, NC.

This 350-acre business park is located at the intersection of US 264 Bypass and Sugg Parkway in Greenville, NC.
