CHEMISTRY

Pure anhydrous caffeine is a bitter-tasting, white, odorless powder with a melting point of 235-238 °C. The xanthine core of caffeine contains two fused rings, a pyrimidinedione and imidazole. The pyrimidinedione in turn contains two amide functional groups that exist predominantly in a zwitterionic resonance


the location from which the nitrogen atoms are double bonded to their adjacent amide carbons atoms. Hence all six of the atoms within the pyrimidinedione ring system are sp2 hybridized and planar. Therefore, the fused 5,6 ring core of caffeine contains a total of ten pi electrons and hence according to Huckel's rule is aromatic

- Inhibits enzyme Phosphodiesterase
- Increases cAMP levels in cells and therefore promotes proliferation by stimulating cell metabolism
 - Counteract Testosterone/DHT-induced miniaturization of the hair follicle



"The beneficial effects of topical application of caffeine in AGA can thus be attributed to inhibition of phosphodiesterase, improvement in barrier function, follicular penetration, stimulation and promotion of hair growth. Thus it appears to be a useful adjuvant in the management of AGA. However, further studies need to be done to confirm and establish the role of caffeine in management of AGA"



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"Results Significant growth suppression was found in hair follicles treated with 5 pg/ml testosterone. This was counteracted by caffeine in concentrations of 0.001% and 0.005%. Moreover, caffeine alone led to a significant stimulation of hair follicle growth. These results were confirmed immunohistochemically by Ki-67 staining."

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

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"0.001% of caffeine prevented the suppressive effect of testosterone on the cultured hair follicles. The stimulatory effect of lower concentrations of caffeine may be partly due to the increased levels of Cyclic AMP and partly due to a direct effect against apoptosis, which is induced in AGA"





- Strengthen existing hair
