The therapeutic cream for hand-foot syndrome is a medical device in the form of a cream, rich in ingredients that form a moisturising-lubricating and protective-regenerative barrier on the skin.

Actions

Hand-foot skin reaction (HFSR)

Associated with multikinase inhibitors (Sunitinib, Axitinib...)

Hand-foot syndrome (HFS)

Associated with agents such as 5-fluorouracil, doxorubicin and capecitabine.

Prevalence

60-80% of patients.

Symptoms

Redness and tenderness.

Peeling of the palms of the hands and soles of the feet.

Dry, numb or tingling skin.
