



Auridol

Ear drops

Lidocaine + anhydrous glycerol solution

- Relieves pain and itching of the external ear canal
- Promotes healing of ear inflammation

Indication:

Otitis externa is a type of inflammation that usually affects the **eardrum, auricle** and **external auditory canal**.

Typical symptoms include: fever, hearing impairment, throbbing pain spreading to the jaw and neck, swelling and blockage of the ear canal.

Inflammation may be **caused** by **bacteria, viral or fungal infections**.



The main ingredient of Auridol is **glycerol** which has two key **characteristics**: its oily texture allows gentle adhesion to the skin and is responsible for its protective properties.

As a **hygroscopic substance**, glycerol **draws water** from **swollen tissues** through an **osmotic effect**, thereby **helping** to reduce swelling and **relieve pain**.

The **glycerol** contained in Auridol **softens earwax** and **helps remove it**. Thanks to its water-binding properties, **it removes excess fluid** from tissues of the ear canal (osmotic effect), **thus eliminating symptoms of ear inflammation such as pain and swelling**.

Lidocaine, used as a local anesthetic in Auridol drops, **enhances** this effect and additionally **relieves ear pain**.

Dosage:

Adults and children older than 6 months: 2 drops in both ears, up to three times daily.
