Water For People is a global nonprofit working across nine countries in Latin America, Asia and Africa to address the global water crisis and equip communities with lasting access to clean water and sanitation services – for Everyone, Forever.

One in four people around the world do not have access to safe water, and one in two billion people lack access to adequate sanitation. Women and children spend more than four hours walking for water each day, and more than 829,000 people die each year from water-related diseases. Water For People (WFP) exists to promote the development of high-quality drinking water and sanitation services, accessible to all, sustained by strong communities, businesses and governments. Working under the tagline Everyone Forever, WFP has become a global and respected organization leading the way in creating sustainable solutions to provide access to safe water and adequate sanitation for 30 years.

Since 2018, we have supported Water For People, a non-profit international development organization, contributing more than \$579,000 USD through employee and corporate contributions. We, at Brenntag, offer a payroll contribution program for all employees and each year our employees get involved and raise funds for the World Water Classic, a Water For People fundraising event.

Additionally, we hold a seat on the WFP Leadership Council since 2018 and were voted into the WFP Executive Council in 2023. Two of our employees hold executive positions on the WFP Canada Board

and four of our employees have received the Miller Founders' Award since 2021. The employees that hold these extra positions and have received recognition do so on a voluntary basis without promise of any reward or benefit.

Annual World Water Classic

Held annually in October, during this virtual event registrants can walk or run 6k, bike 60k or do both. The significance of 6k is that water access directly impacts women and girls, who walk an average of 6k per day to get water in many parts of the world. Since we began participating in this event in 2020, we have raised over \$115,000 USD through employee fundraising efforts coupled with a company match on funds raised.

Water For People promotes safe and reliable water and sanitation services for every family, health clinic, and school. This means every single person – even the hardest to reach, the most vulnerable, the marginalized – has access to safe water and sanitation services. It's not enough to just reach Everyone. We want to make sure water and sanitation

services are sustainable. Forever means working from the ground up and top down – empowering communities and governments so that Water For People won't have to be around forever, but water and sanitation services will be.

POWERING GLOBAL CHANGE

Through strategic partnerships and scaling our Everyone Forever model, we aim to serve 20 million people at the local level and 200 million at the national level with safely managed water, sanitation, and hygiene services.

We call this strategy Destination 2030 in alignment with the target year for the United Nations member countries to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals.
