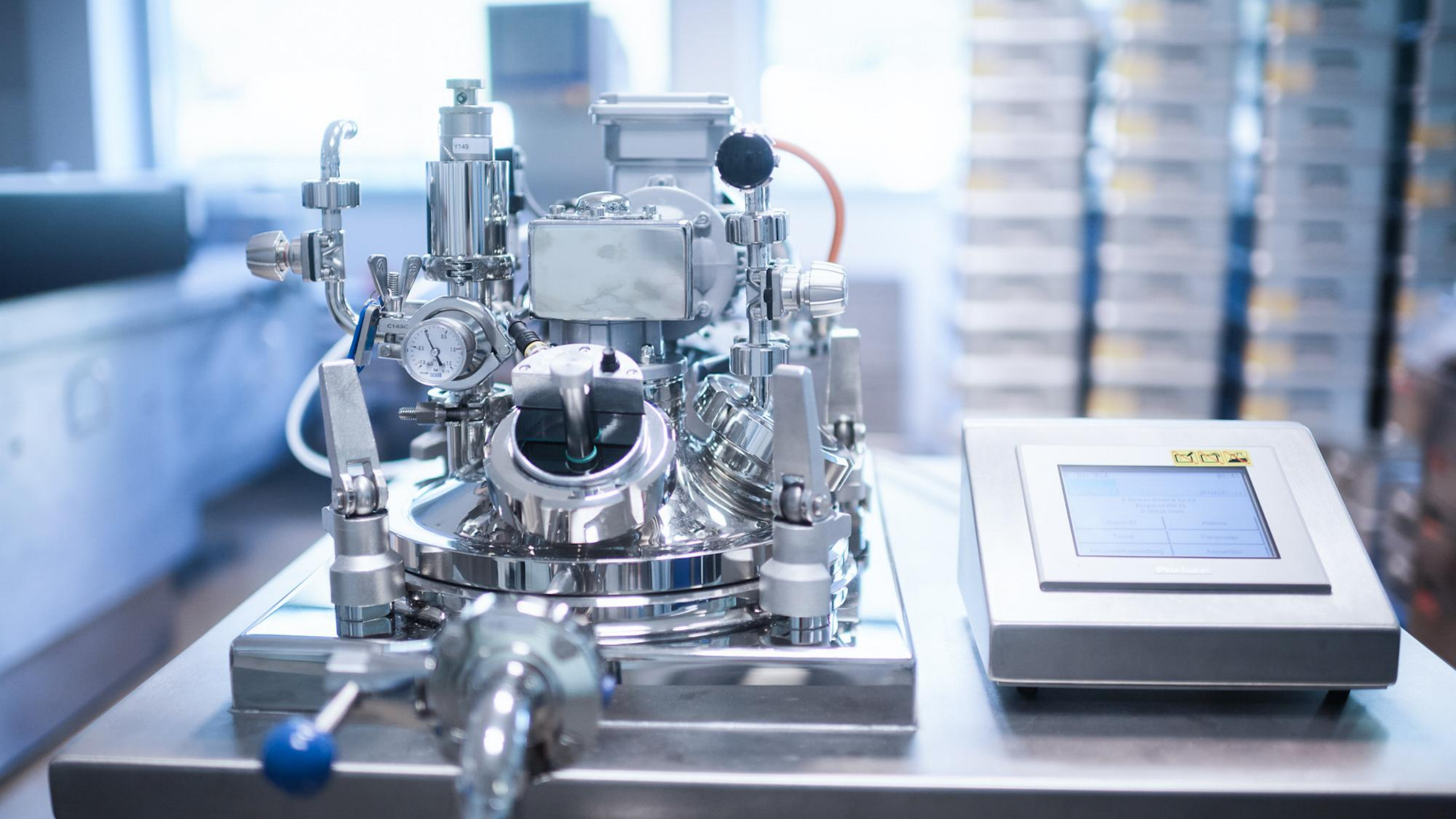

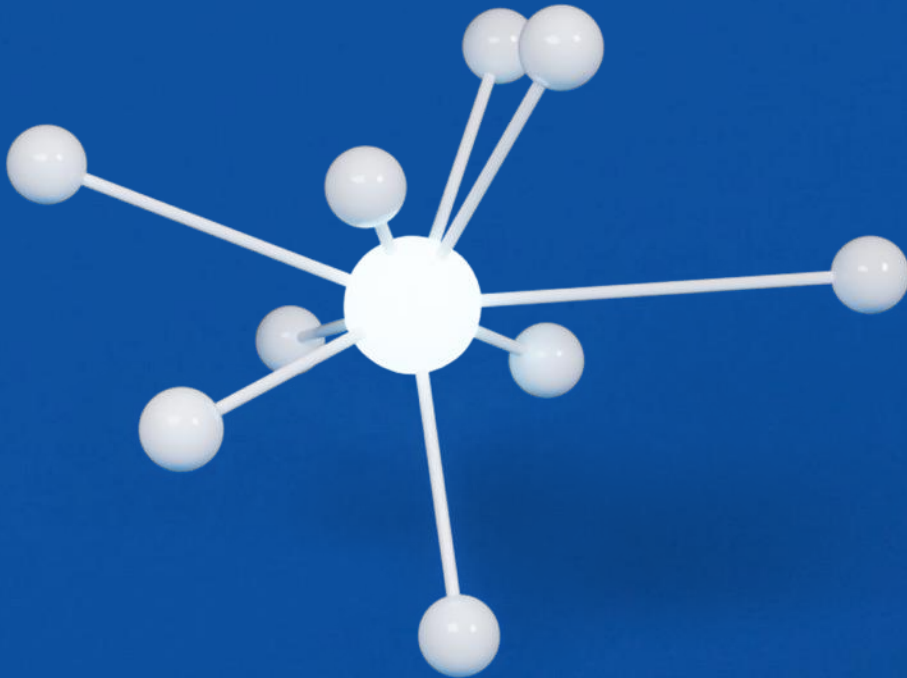

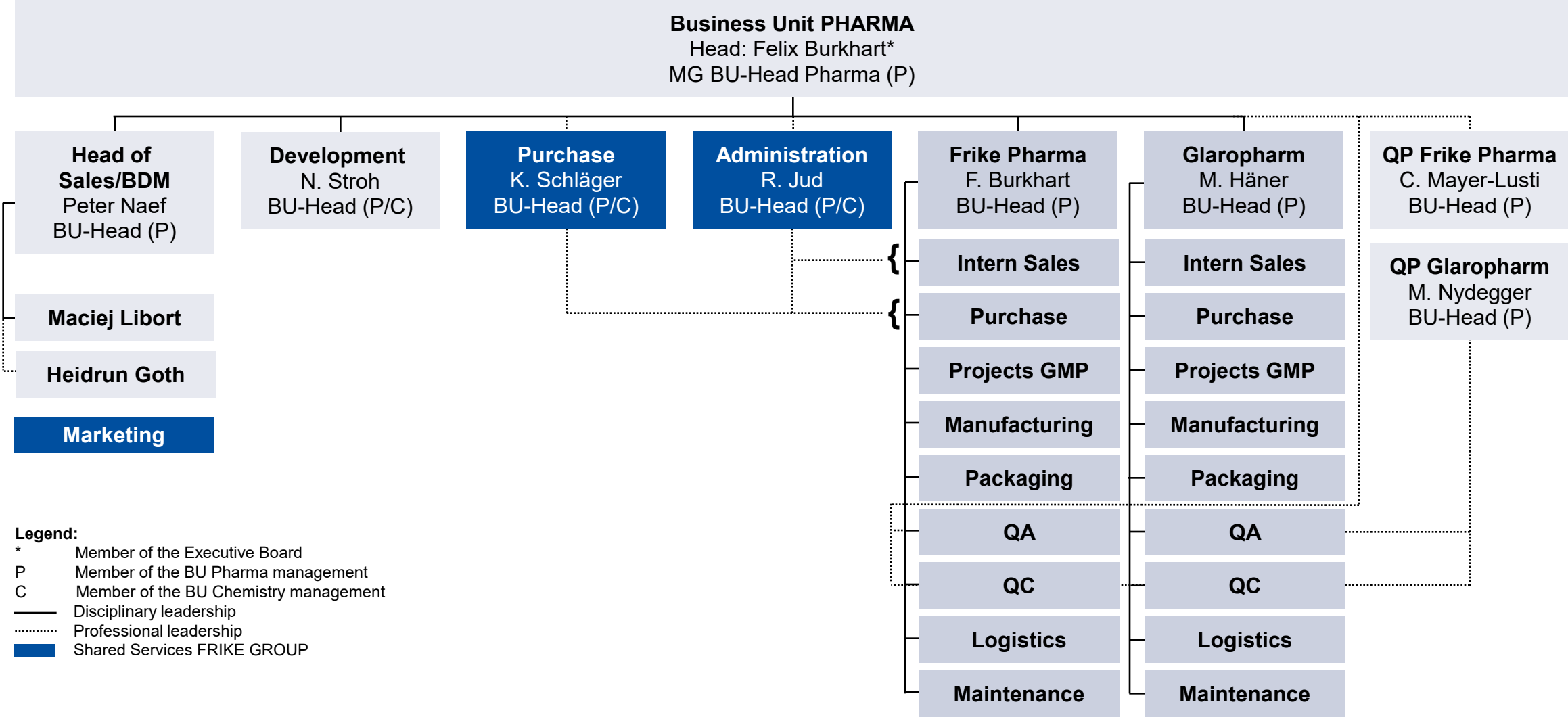

# Responsible Care Programm

The FRIKE GROUP actively participates in the global Responsible Care program. This program is a global chemical and pharmaceutical industry initiative that promotes the safe handling of chemical products throughout their life cycle and emphasizes their contribution to improving quality of life and sustainable development.



# 2026 Certificate from the Energy Agency for Industry

With a target agreement, the FRIKE GROUP has committed itself to targets for increasing energy efficiency and reducing greenhouse gases. By 2025, the FRIKE GROUP is aiming to reduce CO<sub>2</sub> emissions in production by 40%. We have already been able to continuously reduce CO<sub>2</sub> emissions by 31% since 2017.





# Solar roof at the location Ebnat-Kappel

We recently installed a solar system on the roof of our site in Ebnat-Kappel. There, 675 PV modules on an area of around 1500 m<sup>2</sup> generate an annual average of around 300,000 kWh of electricity. In a further step, we are now examining the more intensive use of solar energy at additional locations to bring us closer to our ambitious target step by step. Another solar roof is planned in Wetzikon from 2026. To keep environmental emissions as low as possible, we are constantly switching from fossil steam to electric steam.
