

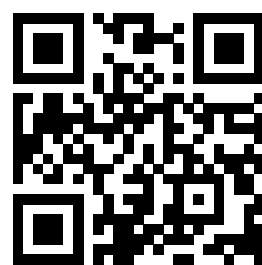

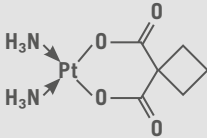

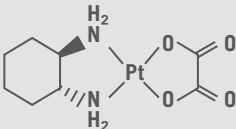

On request, our carboplatin, cisplatin, and oxaliplatin are available using Circlear platinum. Circlear platinum is 100% recycled, originating from secondary sources such as spent chemical or automotive catalysts. This is based on mass balance approach², which is verified by TÜV Süd in accordance with ISO 14021.
